Terms & Conditions

1. This competition is run by Environmental Systems Research Institute Ireland Limited ("Esri Ireland"), registered in the Republic of Ireland under company number 353903. By entering the competition you agree that you will be legally bound by these Terms. We may vary the Terms of the competition, or terminate the competition, at any time without liability to any entrant or other person.
2. All entrants must submit their maps via ArcGIS Online and must use data that is available for public consumption ("Open Data").
3. The entrant's use of ArcGIS Online must comply with Esri Inc's Website and ArcGIS Online's Terms of Use.
4. The entrant's use of Open Data must comply with the relevant data license terms.
5. Entries are not limited to one per person, you may enter as many times as you like.
6. All maps must be submitted by no later than **28th April 2017**.
7. Entries will be judged using the judging criteria on our website.
8. The prize is subject to availability, non transferable and non exchangeable. We reserve the right to replace the stated prizes with prizes we consider to be of broadly equivalent value. We offer no cash alternative and prize winners must accept the prize in the form offered. Flights and accommodation shall be chosen by Esri Ireland at its discretion. The Esri User Conference is in San Diego, California, USA from July 10th – July 14th 2017 and entrants will need to ensure that they are able to attend.
